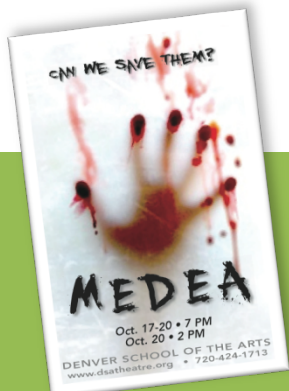


### Important Dates
